Top Accomplishments of 2020

- Asset Growth assets grew to \$146.1 million
- Contributions exceeded \$200 million in cumulative giving since CREATE was established in 1972 (currently over \$208 million).
- **Grant Disbursements -** set a record high of \$11.6 million in grant disbursements in one year.
- Endowment Fund Growth 15 new funds added in 2020
- Toyota Wellspring Career Coach Impact continued successful growth and new additions to Alcorn County, Corinth, Columbus, and Houston with funding from the Governor's

Workforce Initiative and private sources.

- Imagine the Possibilities Career Expo went virtual for 2020.
 An app and website for students and parents were developed, providing major resources for 18 career pathways.

- Endow Mississippi Participation CREATE accounted for nearly 50% of the tax credits available statewide for the program. Almost \$1 Million in qualifying gifts were made to 36 endowment funds at CREATE.
- The Commission on the Future of Northeast MS celebrated its 25th Anniversary in 2020.
- Education Accountability Initiative was launched by the Commission on the Future of Northeast MS
- COVID-19 Relief Fund in partnership with United Way of Northeast MS, raised and distributed over \$500,000 in assistance
- MS Cares Act Initiative CREATE received \$1.6 million from the State of MS for distribution to non-profits and food pantries. A major effort put the staffing, process, and partnerships in place to administer grants.
- CREATE received a 10th consecutive 4-star rating from Charity Navigator for excellence in financial management and growth.
 Only 3% of charities created are in this category.

Strengthening Charitable Giving in Mississippi

Endow Mississippi is a state tax credit program that was created to incentivize individuals, businesses, and organizations to make an impact on their local communities through charitable giving. Under this program, donors are eligible to receive a 25% state tax credit for gifts to endowed funds at the CREATE Foundation.

To receive this state tax credit, donors must make a minimum gift of \$1,000 or a maximum gift of \$200,000 to any endowed fund and fill out the Endow Mississippi Tax Credit application. Gifts must be made by October 31st to receive the tax credit. There are a limited number of tax credits available and they will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.
