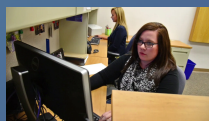

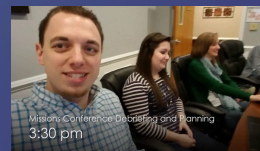
WHAT IS HUMAN SERVICES?

Human Services help individuals and families become healthy and productive members of society. Assistance establishments provide services that include helping the homeless, counseling troubled individuals, training the unemployed and helping families obtain aid. This pathway prepares students for careers in social service agencies, community and civic organizations, child care and charities.

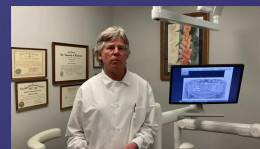
