



## CREATE'S TOP ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF 2022

- Contributions exceeded \$13.8 million for the fifth-highest amount in CREATE's history.
- CREATE, once again, led the state in <u>ENDOW MS</u> with 27 tax credit applications and gifts of \$665,500.
- The Toyota Wellspring Fund continues its momentum with expansion of the <u>Imagine the Possibilities Career Expo</u>, Career Coach Program, and the launch of the Career Connections platform. The Career Coach Program became the model for a statewide initiative.
- Two new Community of Affiliates were established in Prentiss and Pontotoc County.
- The Communities of Excellence initiative was created for Northeast Mississippi communities to encourage, pursue, and achieve excellence in their local areas.
- North Mississippi Youth Foundation Board has students from all 17 counties for the first time.
- 14 endowment funds were established for a total of 290.
- 13 donor advised funds were established for a total of 240.

#### Strengthening Charitable Giving in Mississippi

ENDOW Mississippi is a state tax credit program that was created to incentivize individuals, businesses and organizations to make an impact on their local communities through charitable giving. Under this program, donors are eligible to receive a 25% state tax credit for gifts to endowed funds at the CREATE Foundation. To receive this state tax credit, donors must make a minimum gift of \$1,000 or a maximum gift of \$200,000 to any endowed fund. There are a limited number of tax credits available and they are awarded on a first come first serve basis.

CREATE is accepting applications for gifts in 2023. To ensure that the gift will qualify for the state tax credit, the gift will need to be made by October 31, 2023.
