

The Erby/Cannon Memorial Scholarship

1. The deadline for scholarship applications is **MARCH 8, 2024**.
2. Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements.
3. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
4. If any question does not apply to you in this application, please put N/A in the space.
5. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will be returned.

NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in a four-year, accredited, post-secondary institution.

Purpose:

To provide scholarships to one or more deserving High School graduating senior(s)

Award Components:

1. Scholarships of \$1,000 are awarded to one or more graduating seniors attending a 4-year, accredited college or university.
2. The Erby/Cannon Memorial Scholarship is guaranteed for one year, renewable for three years, with reapplication, proof of satisfactory academic performance, and progress in the field of study.

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a High School senior.
2. Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA or better (both in high school and college, if applicable).
3. Applicant must have demonstrated positive-impact involvement during his or her high school (and college, if applicable) career, with an emphasis on contribution, as opposed to number of activities.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Brief letter with an explanation of career goals and biographical information.
2. Completed application form (if hand-written, please print legibly)
3. Two (2) completed reference forms and two (2) letters of recommendations from high school (or college professors, if applicable) teachers, administrators, counselors, employers, and / or individuals with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement.
4. An official and recent high school (or college if already an HS graduate) transcript with cumulative grade point average, ACT and / or SAT scores, and a class standing / rank. College students should also send high school transcripts.
