- **Stone 1 – Dream Big (start your impossible)**
- **Stone 2 – Risk Taker (take chances and build on them)**
- **Stone 3 – Trust (your skills and abilities to achieve your goals)**
- **Stone 4 – Integrity (it will follow you forever)**
- **Stone 5 – Attitude (can do and will do)**

**Criteria for the Five Smooth Stones Scholarship is as follows:**

1. Must be an African American student
2. Rank in the upper one-half of graduating senior class
3. Provide 2 recommendation letters from teachers.
4. Provide a letter of recommendation from parent or guardian.
5. Write an essay on “How will I use my 5 smooth stones?” (500 words or video)
6. Write a short essay on “Why a college education is important to me” and “How I will give back during my college career”.
