

Application for G43 Chris Greer Scholarship

Overview

The G43 Chris Greer Scholarship was established by the Bo Robbins Family Trust in 2022 in honor of Coach Chris Greer's dedication to Myrtle Attendance Center. The \$2500 scholarship will be awarded each year to a Myrtle student who most exemplifies Coach Greer's personal characteristics of resilience, pride and determination, as well as his coaching principles of building trust, executing goals, and being a team player.

This scholarship is intended to be used by the recipient towards qualified educational expenses including tuition, fees, books and supplies. The scholarship may be used to assist with cost of living to ease the burden of attending full or part-time classes, although such use of funds may not qualify for tax exemption status. The student is responsible for any tax implications that may result from receiving the scholarship.
