Samson "Tiger" Edmond III was a resident of Columbus, MS and a 2002 graduate of West Lowndes High School. Upon his completion from high school, he enlisted in the Army National Guard. He was an Iraqi War Veteran, a Purple Heart Recipient, and a graduate of Mississippi State University. Samson later moved to Hagerstown, MD with his fiancé and worked with the Department of the Navy. - 7. Write an essay (3-5 pages double spaced) on the following question:
 - a. If you had the authority to change your school in a positive way, what specific changes would you make?
- 8. Return your completed application to your high school counselor by March 7, 2025.
