

Simpson Vickery Scholarship Fund

Description

The Simpson Vickery Scholarship Fund is designed to provide a full scholarship (after Pell grants are applied) to a graduating senior at Houston High School. This scholarship will be renewable each year for four years if the student maintains a 2.5 GPA at their chosen college or university. To be eligible for the scholarship, a student should meet the following criteria:

- The student must have minimum average of 80 in high school, verified by the counselor.
- The student will attend a public four-year school in the state of Mississippi.
- The student must score at least an 18 on the ACT.
- The student needs financial aid to attend college.
- The student must write an essay (250 words or less) explaining why he/she is interested in applying for this scholarship and how it would affect the student's future plans.
