



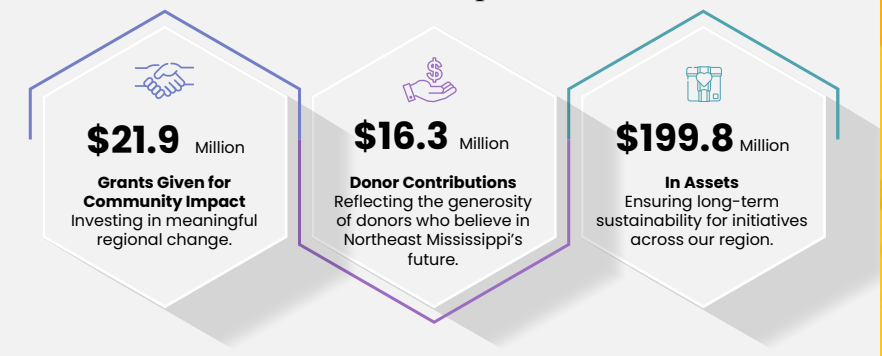

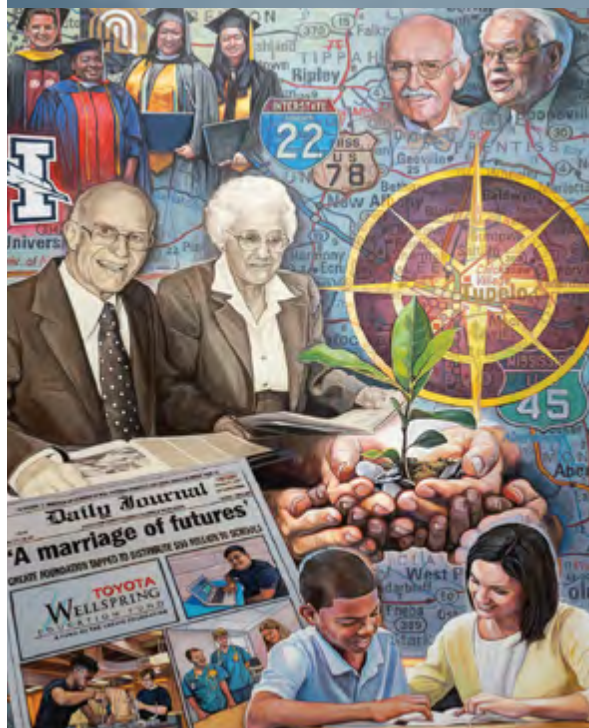

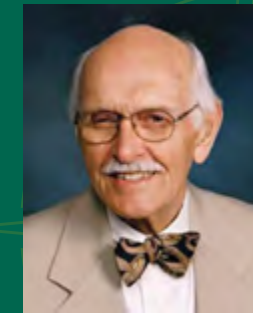

With more than \$150,000 invested directly into students, the program continues to make a lasting impact. Each year, approximately 120 students earn cash awards, while nearly 900 are honored through PACE Awards celebrations.

The impact is measurable and meaningful. Every participating school has improved its academic performance, with most advancing two letter grades. Just as importantly, PACE Incentive Program has become a tradition - one students and families look forward to year after year.

What Is a Donor Advised Fund?

A Donor Advised Fund allows you to make a charitable contribution, receive an immediate tax benefit, and recommend grants to nonprofits over time. It's a streamlined approach to giving - designed to amplify your impact while simplifying the process.

A Family Approach to Giving

Matt and Amy Bogue established a Donor Advised Fund (DAF) with CREATE Foundation as a way to simplify and strengthen their family's approach to giving. "The Donor Advised Fund affords us the immediate tax benefits of our charitable contributions while also allowing us to give strategically based on our own timeline, not the calendar," said Matt. The fund has also created a meaningful opportunity to involve their children, encouraging them to take an active role in charitable decisions and develop a lifelong commitment to giving.

"The DAF has also allowed us to teach our children about charitable giving by trusting them with the responsibility of allocating funds to some of the charities they are most passionate about," said Matt. After four years, the Bogue family describes their experience with CREATE as seamless and rewarding. "The CREATE staff is incredibly helpful and responsive to any questions, concerns, or ideas we have," said Matt. "We could not be happier with our decision to work with CREATE to establish this fund."

Through CREATE's Special Project Fund, Home of El Roi was able to begin fundraising immediately - before securing its own nonprofit status - allowing early momentum to build at a critical time.



Home of El Roi

Restoring hope. Rebuilding families.

Home of El Roi provides 18 - 24 months of life recovery for single mothers and their children - offering support, stability, and a path forward. Serving women who are committed to positive change, the program helps families overcome challenges, rebuild relationships, and create a stronger foundation for the future.



The fund also helped establish sustainable support, including partnerships with local churches and transformative early gifts that funded key renovations and program development. As awareness of our vision grew throughout the community, so did the interest in supporting it. Because CREATE provided a trusted, tax-deductible giving vehicle, we did not have to turn away generous individuals and businesses who wanted to contribute," said Lane Yoder, Director of Development and Marketing for Home of El Roi. "We could gratefully receive their gifts and steward them well from the beginning.

With CREATE's support, Home of El Roi has been able to focus on what matters most - restoring lives and strengthening families.

Honoring a Legacy of Giving

Honoring a legacy of giving begins with thoughtful planning and a commitment to making a lasting difference. For more than 25 years, Sandy and Rosemary Williams have partnered with CREATE Foundation to support the causes and communities they care about most. Through a Donor Advised Fund, scholarship support, contributions to (C.A.R.E.), Alcorn County's Community Affiliate and the establishment of a personal charitable endowment, their approach to giving reflects both intention and impact.

As members of the George McLean Legacy Society, they have further extended that commitment by designating a \$100,000 life insurance policy to benefit C.A.R.E. - a meaningful gift made possible through a simple and accessible process.

For Sandy and Rosemary, estate planning has been the key to making these opportunities achievable. "Very little of this would have been done without estate planning," said Sandy. "While estate planning sounds complicated and out of reach, that is not necessarily so."

Their experience is a testament to the value of planning ahead. "It is a worthy thing to do and it really doesn't matter how many or how few zeros you have on your adjusted gross income line. Plus, your family will be delighted that you have had the foresight to do this," said Sandy.

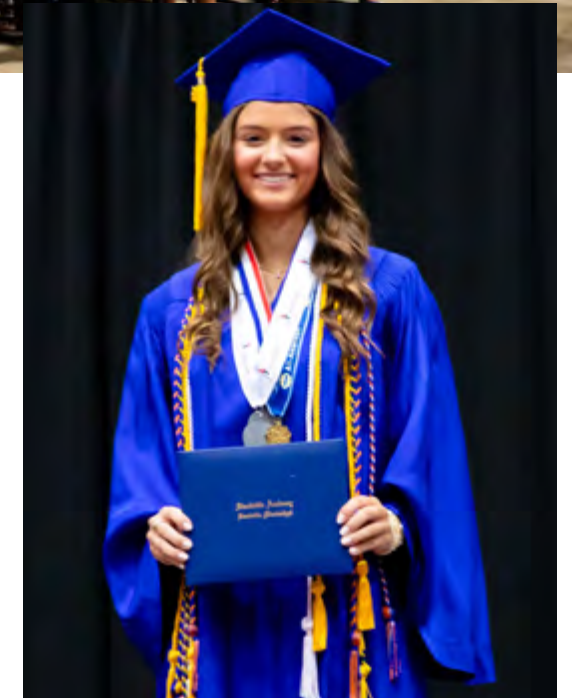

John and Frances Marchbanks believed deeply in the power of giving back. Although John had not lived in Shannon for more than 60 years, his connection to the community remained strong. Together, he and Frances shared a commitment to helping others overcome challenges, build meaningful lives, and improve their quality of life.

In 2005, their generosity took shape in a remarkable way. Through a gift of \$8.7 million from their estate, they established the Marchbanks Endowment Fund to benefit communities – primarily in Lee County.

Since its inception, the fund has awarded more than \$5.3 million in grants and scholarships, supporting initiatives that strengthen communities, expand opportunities, and improve lives across the region.

The Molls gave generously – not only financially, but through their leadership and service as volunteers and board members. Their commitment was rooted in a genuine desire to create opportunity and improve the lives of others.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Dear Friends,

The CREATE portfolio achieved an investment return of 18.39% in 2025, building on the strong double-digit performance from 2024. With a target allocation of 75% to equities and 25% fixed income, our equity investments have been the primary driver of recent gains. While periods of underperformance are inevitable, we expect our allocation mix will continue to generate excess returns that outpace more conservative investments.

We are proud that CREATE was the first community foundation in the nation to earn the CEFEX certification from the Center for Fiduciary Excellence, and we have maintained that certification every year since. This framework continues to guide our approach and reinforces our commitment to thoughtful and informed investment decisions for CREATE.

While returns have been impressive the past few years, our long-term success depends on maintaining perspective and not getting caught up in short-term results. Despite challenges such as armed and geopolitical conflicts, and trade disruption, CREATE's diversified portfolio has delivered an average annual return of 7.82% over the past 15 years, and has outperformed our community foundation peer group in every time period except one.

Market fluctuations will continue to be unpredictable. Our Investment Committee remains committed to its disciplined, long-term strategy to fulfill the goals of our dedicated donors. The CREATE portfolio continues to grow to allow donors to cast an even greater impact on the communities we serve.
